## ORDER NO. 2 MEMORALIZING PREHEARING CONFERENCE AND ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On March 6, 2008, the Electric Reliability Council of Texas, Inc. (ERCOT) filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application for approval of a revised surcharge to fund its efforts to implement a Nodal Market design pursuant to P.U.C. SUBST. R. 25.363, P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.252 and the Commission's Orders in Docket No. 32686.<sup>1</sup>

Appearances. On March 19, 2008, a prehearing conference was held in this proceeding. The following parties entered appearances: ERCOT, Commission Staff, Chaparral Steel Midlothian, L.P. (Chaparral), Brownsville Public Utilities Board (Brownsville PUB), Texas Industrial Energy Consumers (TIEC), The Steering Committee of Cities Served by Oncor (Cities), Competitive Market Participants (CMP), and CPS Energy.

The Office of Public Utility Counsel (OPUC) and the City of Garland/Denton entered appearances and indicated their intention to file motions to intervene subsequent to the prehearing conference.

Motions to Intervene. Having filed motions to intervene prior to the prehearing conference, the following entities were granted party status: Cities, Brownsville PUB, Chaparral, CPS Energy, and TIEC. In addition, the motion to intervene of CMP is granted.

Intervention Deadline. The intervention deadline of March 31, 2008, proposed by the parties is approved. Pursuant to P.U.C. PROC. R. 22.252(d)(8), the parties shall include a statement of position containing a concise statement of the requestor's position on the application, a concise statement of each question of fact, law, or policy that the requestor considers at issue and a concise statement of the requestor's position on each issue identified.

Allocation Formula. Included in the application is ERCOT's request that the Commission maintain the allocation formula for the Nodal Surcharge approved in Docket No. 32686. Allocation of the surcharge was a key issue in the prior docket and the Commission determined that the nodal surcharge should be allocated to qualified scheduling entities (QSEs) representing generation resources. If a party objects to ERCOT's proposal on the allocation formula, objections shall be filed no later than March 31, 2008. Objections to the allocation issue, if not raised by March 31, 2008, are waived.

Notice. On March 14, 2008, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on notice. ERCOT proposes to provide notice of its application by electronic mail to all entities subject to the ERCOT System Administration Fee and to all parties in Docket No. 32686 and in its most recent fee case, Docket No. 31824.<sup>2</sup> In addition, ERCOT proposes to post the notice and a copy of its application on its website. Commission Staff stated that the notice proposed by ERCOT is consistent with the requirements of P.U.C. PROC. R. 2.252(d). Commission Staff recommended that ERCOT's notice be deemed sufficient. Based on Commission Staff's recommendation, the notice proposed by ERCOT is deemed sufficient. ERCOT's notice shall reflect the deadline established for intervention in this proceeding.
