This new website will run in parallel to the <u>existing MIS website</u> until January 2021 when the existing MIS will be decommissioned. The new MIS can be accessed using your existing Digital Certificate(s) and role(s).

The website performs in Chrome and Internet Explorer 9+. If your organization uses an older version of Internet Explorer, please see ERCOT's <u>Internet Explorer (IE) 11.x Configuration</u> <u>Guide</u> for compatibility and configuration instructions.

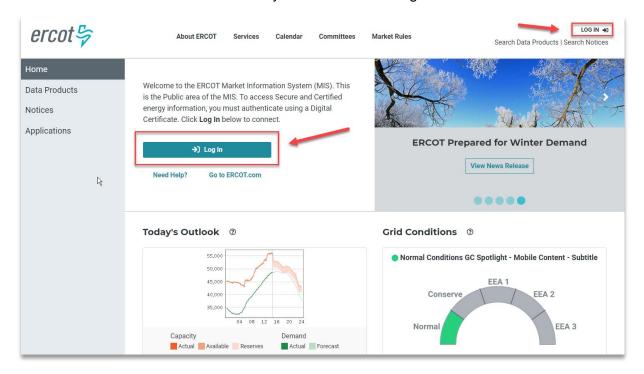

What is available in the full Production Release of MIS?

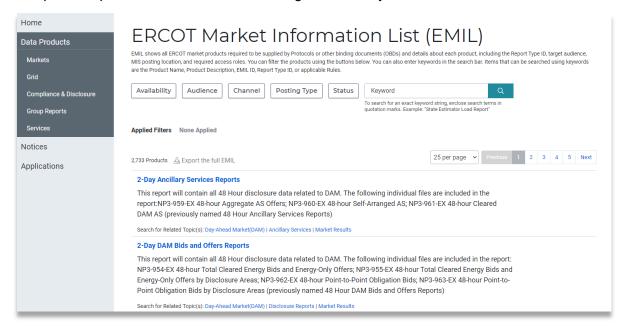
Digital Certificates – Use your existing Digital Certificate(s) to authenticate with the redesigned MIS. You will see information based on your role. Click the log in button to authenticate.



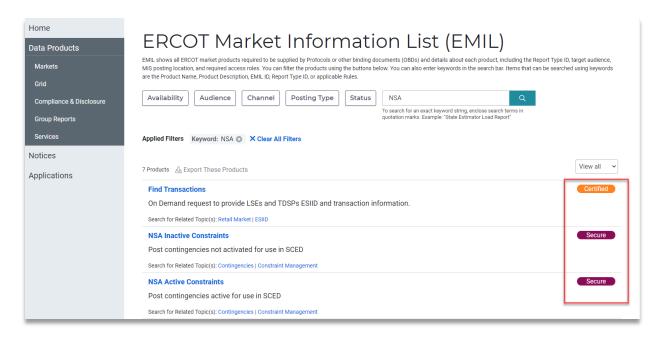
MIS badge – Visual cue letting you know when you are authenticated to MIS and are able to see Secure and Certified data.



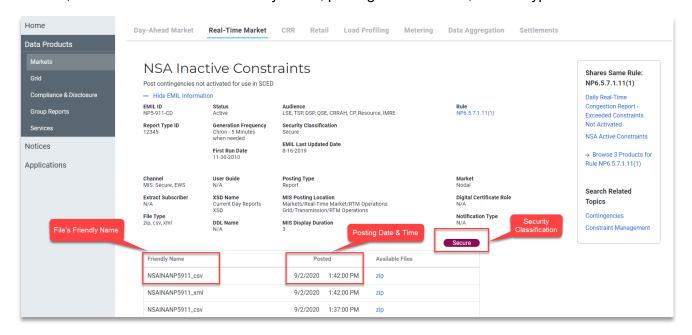
EMIL data product search – Search for all reports, extracts, notices, and applications ERCOT is required to provide. Narrow a search using filters or keywords.



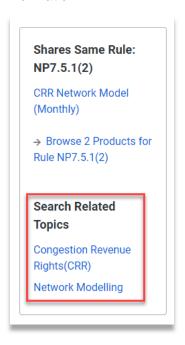
Access to data (Public, Secure, and Certified) – Role-based access to data products.



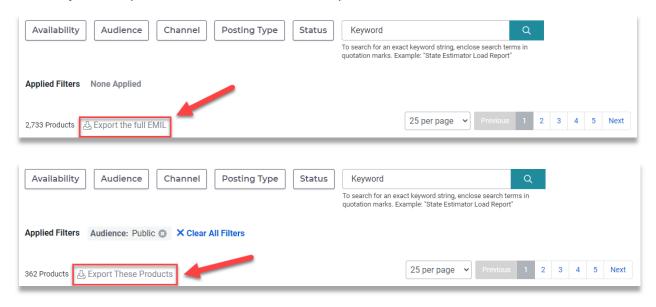
The data details page displays the EMIL information for the report and/or extract, such as generation frequency, Digital Certificate role required to access the product, and more. If you have access to the EMIL data product, you will also find a list of available reports and/or extracts, which includes the file's friendly name, posting date and time, and file type.



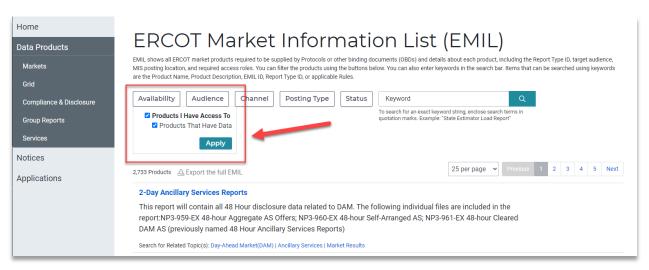
Topics – Tags on data products that, when clicked, allows the user to see similar reports or information.



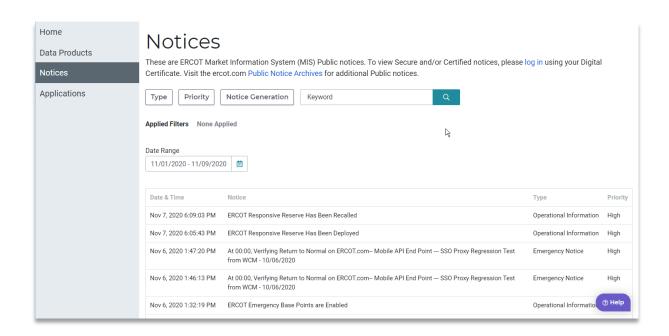
EMIL export – Export the full EMIL or a subset of products in an Excel file.



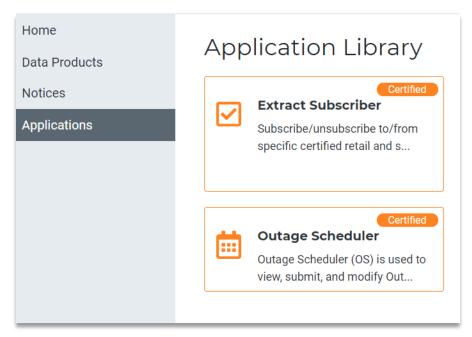
Availability filter – Allows a user to limit reports to just those they have access to and just those that have data.



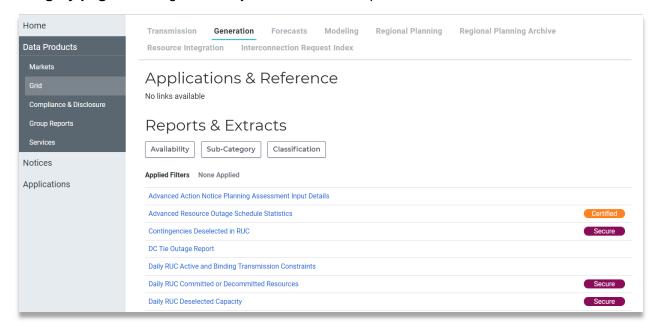
Notices – Search ERCOT Public notices. Log in to search Secure and/or Certified notices. Filter results by type, priority, how they were generated, keyword, and date range.



Applications – Role-based access to ERCOT applications can be accessed from the Applications page.



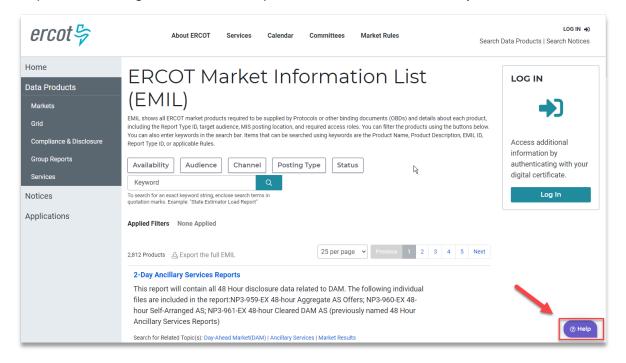
Category pages – Navigate directly to collections of reports and extracts.
