Hey Leslie:

Based off the information I was able to pull from ERCOT's annual Weatherization Workshops, can you provide us with the names of the plants that received spot checks and reports showing what needed improvement? We recognize that ERCOT does not certify a generator is prepared for winter operations and every plant is left with recommendations to improve reliability but it would be helpful to review the documents. In one of the press conferences this week, either Dan or Bill suggested that on average ERCOT conducts about 100 spot checks per year. Based off what I was able to pull it looks like it's more like 67 per year. Do you have the numbers for 2017 and 2016 so we can get a more complete picture of the spot checks conducted?

In addition, could you give me the report showing what plants experienced failures in 2011? If any of this is subject to open records, please consider this a formal open records request under the Texas Open Records Act.

We would like to extend an interview request with Bill and/or Allen Allgower, to better understand these workshops and the agency's role in making sure their partners are prepared for the weather. Please let us know you've received this request.
