

ERCOT has made enhancements to ERCOT.com based upon Market Participant feedback. Here are the updated items you will notice after the March 3, 2022, release.


Popular grid conditions dashboards are added to the home page


Upcoming meetings appear in list view by default on the Meeting Calendar page


Spotlight areas draw attention to items of importance in the site navigation

Timely and/or newsworthy items are highlighted within the website's top navigation for increased awareness.




Grid conditions dashboards reflect Daylight Saving Time (DST) changes on affected days
