

ERCOT.com Production Release Notes

Release Date: December 3, 2022

ERCOT has made enhancements to ERCOT.com based upon Market Participant feedback. Here are the updated items you will notice after the December 3, 2022, release.

Enhanced search

The ERCOT.com search now defaults to providing returns from the past three years. No more wading through old items to find the latest. If you are searching for an item from three or more years ago, simply adjust the **Date Range** filter.

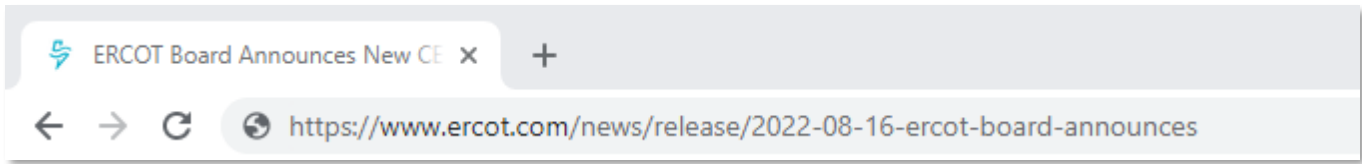
Helpful links to access dashboards from the EMIL

More meaningful URLs

The URLs for news releases, calendar events, and Market Notices on the ERCOT website have been adjusted to include the first four words from the title of the release, event, or notice. This will make the URLs more meaningful and easier to distinguish.



Enhanced Meeting Calendar

It's now easier to add multiple upcoming meetings to your personal calendar. Check the box next to **All** to quickly select all upcoming meetings; then click **Add Selected to Calendar**.

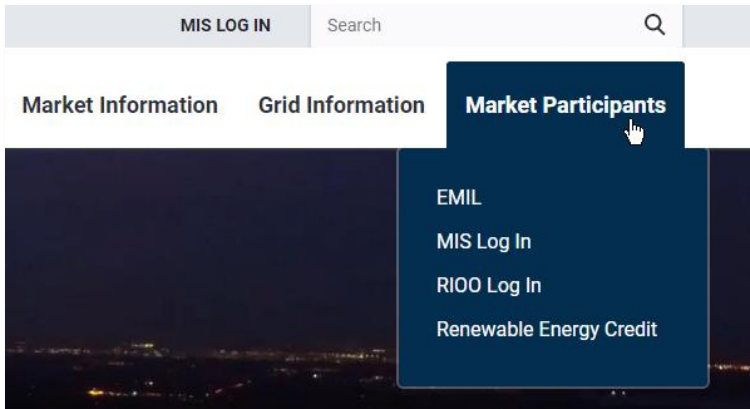

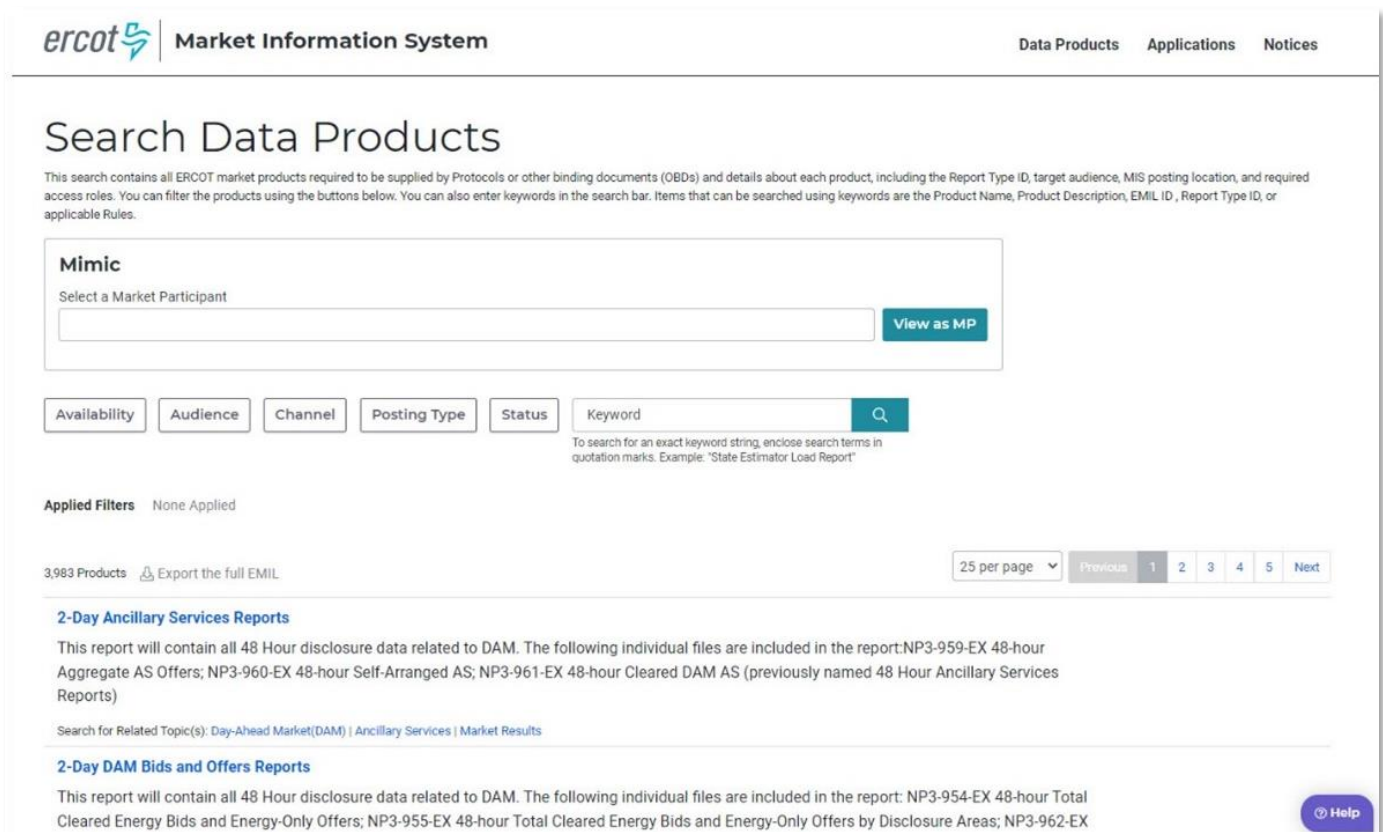
Streamlined user experience for Market Participant section

The Market Participant section of ERCOT.com is the entry point for Market Participants to access the ERCOT Market Information List (EMIL) and, if desired, log in to the Market Information System (MIS) with a digital certificate to access Market Participant-specific Secure and Certified information. The navigation has been streamlined to offer links to the most-visited Market Participant areas: the EMIL search page, the MIS Log In, the RIOO Log In, and the Renewable Energy Credit website.



Market Information System (MIS) update

Along with the above enhancements to ERCOT.com, MIS users will notice the removal of the Market Participant home page once logged in to MIS. MIS users will now be directed to the Search Data Products page for quicker access to the catalog of Protocol-required postings.



In the future (planned Q1 2023), ERCOT.com will house all Public report information. The MIS will only house Secure and Certified report information.
